1		Tee shot should be placed left of bunker on the right side of the fairway. Long hitters can go for the green in two, but the safe play is to lay-up to the left center of the fairway to the 100 yard marker. Green depth 35 yds. width 16 yds.
2		Right side of the fairway, left of bunker is the preferred position. Second shot is downhill to a large multilevel green. Green depth 30 yds. width 20 yds.
3		CARRY! CARRY! CARRY! Don't be short or you will never find your ball. This hole plays its true yardage, wind is a very critical factor in club selection. Green depth 29 yds. width 30 yds.
4		Accuracy! Club selection off the tee is critical. Favor left side of the fairway with a long iron or fairway wood. Be aware of ravine in front of green on your lay-up shot. Approach shot to the green sloping from back to front is dangerous. Green depth 21 yds. width 23 yds.
5		Short dog leg left par 4. Tee shot should be toward the left of the furthest mound on the right, leaves a short iron to a large sloping green. Green depth 34 yds. width 33 yds.
6		The shot to this slightly uphill par three should favor the center of the green to avoid the large bunker on the left and deep ominous bunker on the right. Green depth 41 yds. width 30 yds.
7		The tee shot should be hit right of center, because the fairway slopes left. The approach is to an elevated, well bunkered green. Green depth 33 yds. width 31 yds.
8		Very unique par 5! Favor left side of the fairway with a long iron or fairway wood. A carefully placed lay-up right of the large mounds on line with the large rock with pampas plants on each side of it. This will leave a short iron to a very narrow green. Green depth 49 yds. width 13 yds.
9		Slightly uphill, large green with a spectacular view, this par 3 is dangerous. Do not trust the flag, check the wave direction of the lake for true wind direction. Green depth 49 yds. width 35 yds.

10		The fairway slopes right; favor the left side off the tee. Beware the deep bunker guarding the front left of the green. Green depth 26 yds. width 35 yds.
11		Aim the tee shot just left of the fairway bunker, too far left is history! Before the approach shot, check the pin position; everything rolls right on this green. Green depth 53 yds. width 15 yds.
12		Innocent looking par 3! Left of the green over large mound will leave a very difficult recovery. Green depth 30 yds. width 19 yds.
13		Conservative players aim tee shot toward the bunker. Longer hitters aim further right. This two tiered green slopes severely to the right. Green depth 37 yds. width 24 yds.
14		Great par 4! Fairway slopes right and drive should be placed left of center. Approach is a very difficult one to a small green across a deep ravine. Check wind direction! Green depth 31 yds. width 28 yds.
15		What a par 3! It plays downhill with a drop of between 40 to 100 feet to a postage stamp green. Wilderness short, water right, trees left and a swirling wind. Severely sloping cart path. Please drive slowly! Green depth 33 yds. width 17 yds.
16		Right center of fairway is the preferred position. Avoid large canyon to the left. Second shot should be a lay-up to about 150 yards favoring right side because of the slope. Be aware of rock hazard short of green. Green depth 29 yds. width 20 yds.
17		Aim tee shot right of center to allow for the slight slope to the left. The approach shot is very deceptive to this elevated, very undulated green. Knowing the pin location is very critical. Green depth 42 yds. width 19 yds.
18		Great finishing hole. Aim tee shot between bunkers on the left and rocks on the right. Approach is to a narrow green with water to the left. Green depth 38 yds. width 18 yds.
